

Portesbery School Home/School Agreement



In accordance with our Vision and Values, the school will:-

- let parents and carers know if their child has made a significant achievement
- contact parents and carers if there is a problem with attendance, punctuality or equipment
- let parents and carers know if their child has been unwell or has had an accident
- let parents and carers know about any concerns or problems that affect their child's work or behaviour
- set targets for Individual Education Plans
- arrange Annual Review and Parent's Evenings where progress will be discussed
- keep parents and carers informed about school events through regular letters home, newsletters and notices about special events
- provide opportunities for parents and carers to meet each other (Portesbery Partnerships)
- communicate regularly with parents and carers using the Home/School Books
- promote independence and self-help skills
- respect confidentiality

As Parent/Carer(s), I/we will:-

- see that my child goes to school regularly, on time and properly equipped (including personal care items)
- make an appointment to speak to the teachers and avoid trying to discuss things at busy times (i.e. the beginning and end of the day)
- ask permission from the Head Teacher to request exceptional leave
- inform the school when my child is going into respite care
- let the school know when my child is unwell, has had an accident at home or overnight or taken medicine (including paracetamol)
- abide by the Policy for Medication for Parents/Guardians and adhere to the Sickness policy (48 hours)
- support the school's policies and guidelines for behaviour
- support the strategies that my child uses at school, at home
- label all clothing and equipment belonging to my child and accept full responsibility for things that are lost in school and not labeled
- attend Parent's Evening and Annual Reviews to discuss my child's progress
- communicate regularly with the school using the Home/School book or by telephoning the school office during the school day
- not use Social Media to air grievances and make every attempt to contact school directly
- respect confidentiality
